#### Johnson Sets Receiving Marks as Football Rolls in Return, 41-12

Senior wide receiver Carsen Johnson set school records for receiving yards and yards per catch finishing with five for 212 yards and a touchdown as Montclair State rolled past Kean University, 41-12 in its return to action since the end of the 2019 season. Johnson broke the single-game mark of 197 set by Bryan Scipio against Kean in 1986 and equaled by Eric Magrini versus Iona in 2001. Johnson averaged 42.4 yards per reception, breaking Amod Field's 1989 mark of 38.2 at Trenton State (now The College of NJ). [Read more]

Freshman Aileen Cahill netted the game-winning goal in the 50th minute as the Montclair State women's soccer team edged New Jersey City 2-1 in New Jersey Athletic Conference play Saturday afternoon. Fellow freshman Samantha Gabriele tallied the other goal for the Red Hawks (1-0-1, 1-0-1 NJAC), while Kim Brites scored the lone marker for the Gothic Knight (0-1-0, 0-1-0 NJAC).
