### **Staying Focused on Social Justice**

Twenty-three years ago, Rayshawn Brown, Jarmaine Grant, Keshon Moore and Danny Reyes, were headed to North Carolina to pursue their dreams of attending a four-year college and playing professional basketball. But their dreams ended when they were pulled over by police on the New Jersey Turnpike and all ended up shot by police. Now known as the "Jersey Four" their story continues to resonate today, particularly in the wake of so many high-profile killings by police, including George Floyd and Breonna Taylor. Three of the Jersey Four – Brown, Grant and Reyes – participated in a panel discussion on February 16, 2022, at the Montclair State University School of Communication and Media, hosted by the Black Alumni Advisory Council and moderated by Justice Studies Professor Jason Williams, a social justice activist and criminologist whose research focuses on racial and gender disparities and abuse in the legal system. 
