The remarkable tale of their journey to adopting that baby, whom they named Kevin, is detailed in *Our Subway Baby*, illustrated by Leo Espinosa. The book, published in 2020 by Penguin Random House, is a selection on the ALA Rainbow Book List for Young Readers and a Lambda Literary Award finalist.
