

Anthology Portfolio (formerly Chalk and Wire) Guide for Faculty


Embedding a Key Anthology Portfolio Assignment into your CANVAS course

The College of Education and Human Services will begin using Anthology Portfolio in the fall of 2021 as our comprehensive assessment and accreditation management system. All key assessments, edTPA portfolios, clinical assessments and certification requirements will be collected, processed, and stored in Anthology Portfolio. This platform is where faculty, mentors and cooperating teachers will enter the evaluations of teacher candidates and clinical interns. Likewise, all teacher candidates will use Anthology Portfolio to submit key assessments, review the evaluations from faculty, CTs and Mentors, submit time logs, and upload and submit their edTPA portfolios.




Follow these steps to embed a key assessment from Anthology into you're your Canvas course:


- Step 1. Open the course in Canvas that contains the course embedded assessment.
- Step 2. Click on the assignments link.
- Step 3. Click on Add Assignment.



Step 4. Name the assignment the same name of the assignment in Anthology. (See list of key assignments at end of this document.)




Step 5. Select External Tool from the drop-down menu in the Submission Type option.






Step 6. Select Chalk and Wire from the Find drop down menu and click Select.



Step 7. Check the box for Load This Tool in a New Tab.



Step 8. Continue to add due dates and other options as you normally would for the assignment.




Step 10. Navigate back to your list of assignments in Canvas and click on the assignment you just created. Click the button to open the assignment in a new window. This will bring up



two drop down menus - Department and Table of Contents. **Please note:** You will only need to do this step one time. The settings will save from semester to semester.

- 1. For Department Select: Teacher Education Program.
- 2. For Table of Contents, select the program relevant to your course: Early Childhood and Elementary OR P-12 Subject Area.
- 3. Select the relevant assignment name.
- 4. Click SAVE.




