☐ Substitute Teaching License Requirement - Deadline: 3 months after completing 60 credits  Students are required to have a New Jersey Substitute Teaching License before starting the Professional Sequence. You are Substitute Teaching License once you have earned 60 credits. Students are advised to start this process as soon as possible three months to complete. Consult Canvas or Teacher Ed. Advisor for more information.	
Praxis Subject Assessment - Baseline Score Deadline: December 15th (Year II Fall Semester)  The New Jersey Department of Education requires all candidates to achieve a minimum score on the Praxis Subject Assessment regarding which test to register for and how to register is available on www.ets.org/praxis. Students are urged to take the test as early as possible and to report both passing and non-passing scores to the Center of Pedagogy.
