Montclair Syllabus by Simple Syllabus

This spring semester the Montclair Syllabus by Simple Syllabus will be the only syllabus available to instructors in Canvas. This new template was used in over half of the University's courses this Fall, and has been positively reviewed by instructors.

Changes to the Calendar: Impact for Spring Terms
