The World on Display — 33rd Summer Olympics

The 2024 Summer Olympics take place in Paris, where 10,000 of the world's greatest athletes will come together to run, jump, and swim their way to a spot on the Olympic



podium. For athletes in many sports, there is no greater achievement than earning an Olympic medal. Here's what you need to know about this year's games...

When are the Olympics?
The Opening Ceremony for the 33rd Olympiad will take

place on Friday, July 26 with an exciting outdoor flair. This year, rather than marching into a stadium, the international athletes will ride on barges down the Seine River. The games will officially close on Sunday, August 11.


Where can you watch? The Olympics will be aired on NBC and its affiliate stations, with at least 9 hours of daily programming. Every event can be streamed on Peacock.



The beach volleyball competition will take place with spectacular views of the Eiffel Tower.

What are the medals made from? Each gold, silver and bronze medal contains a small piece of original iron from the Eiffel Tower that was removed and conserved during renovations over the years.

What is the Olympic mascot? The official 2024 mascots are adorable cartoonish hats that embody an ideal with deep historical significance in France. The Phryges (pronounced free-jee-us) represent the cap worn during the French Revolution as a



symbol of liberty. There are two official main characters, one representing the Olympics and the other—with a prosthetic leg—symbolizing the Paralympics.

Who's representing the USA? The final rosters are not de-

termined until just before the Olympics begin, but check out the <u>Team USA website</u> to see who has made it so far. Some familiar faces and names could be:
