The MA in Music at Montclair State University offers three different concentration options to suit each student's specific career goals. The program offers both fall and spring starts and operates on a rolling admissions basis.

Concentrations Options

Music Education

The 33-hour MA in Music Education program is for music teachers seeking advanced skills in music and pedagogy. The program also fosters a balance of theory and practice to nurture musical maturity, reflective teaching practice and educational leadership*

*NOTE: A U.S.-teaching certificate or completion of an alternate routed music education program is required for admission into this program.

Music Therapy

This 40.5 credit program offers a combination of supportive psychology and research courses including courses in assessment, clinical improvisation techniques, group music therapy (experiential and client centered), and teaching and supervision.

Music Theory/Composition

This 32-credit program offers advanced studies to support the development of students' personal styles. The goal of the composition program is to prepare students for the professional music world and doctoral program and is open to all styles of music.
