#### UNDERGRADUATE FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIPS

Undergraduate freshmen applicants are automatically reviewed for partial merit-based Presidential Scholarships. Scholarships are highly competitive and based on the academic profile.

#### Application deadline:

- March 1 for fall
- Spring applicants should apply early for maximum consideration

### UNDERGRADUATE TALENT-BASED PERFORMING ARTS AWARDS

Students admitted to select performing arts programs in Dance, Musical Theatre, Music and Theatre may be awarded a talent-based scholarship by the faculty based on the strength of their audition.

#### **GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS**

The Graduate School offers a very limited number of highly competitive assistantships for degree-seeking graduate students who are interested in an opportunity to gain an academic experience that directly complements the student's degree program curriculum. Assistantships will offer opportunities to work with faculty on research, assist faculty with instructional support and/or be related to the student's clinical or field work.

#### Graduate assistantship application process:

All applicants must undergo a review and approval process which involves initial review by the academic department, interview of potential candidates (at the department's discretion), recommendation for a position by the department, and approval by both The Graduate School and the Dean's Office of the college that houses the recommending academic department.

As assistantship opportunities are limited and highly competitive, graduate students should be prepared to self-fund their studies.
