Materials Challenge Policy 2025

Montclair State University Libraries

It is the policy of the Montclair State University Libraries that materials acquired or produced as part of the Libraries' collections will not subsequently be withdrawn based on allegations of false, misleading, pejorative, defamatory, offensive, or potentially harmful content. As a library, our materials are provided for the interest, information, and enlightenment of the communities the Libraries serve. The Libraries do not exclude materials because of the origin, background, or views of those contributing to their creation.

The Libraries understand that authors, creators, or collectors may, intentionally or inadvertently, misstate facts, reach erroneous conclusions, or make claims that may, in fact or in perception, be hurtful to individuals or lead future researchers astray. It is not the task of the Libraries to verify or validate the contents of what it acquires, but it is to make research available for review, rebuttal, substantiation, support or further inquiry as well as correct known errors issued by publishers.

It is the position of the Montclair State University Libraries that claims and counterclaims are the essence of what is protected as academic freedom and that the Libraries have no role mediating these interchanges. Our policy is that materials acquired by the Libraries stand as published. Barring exceptional legal or ethical circumstances, any requests to remove items will be declined.
