Because the Biological Material is experimental in nature, IT IS PROVIDED WITHOUT ANY WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. In no event shall MSU be liable for any use of the Biological Material, and RECIPIENT hereby agrees to defend, indemnify and hold MSU harmless from any loss, claim, damage, or liability, which may arise from Recipient's use, storage and disposal of the Biological Material, except to the extent such loss, damage or liability is the direct result of MSU's gross negligence or willful misconduct.
