Matters Presented by the Chair - Dr. Francis Cuss

Dr. Cuss reported that in closed session, the Trustees reviewed the minutes from December 13, 2019, reviewed legal matters, heard reports from the Committee Chairs, and received updates regarding contract negotiations.

Matters Presented by the President - Dr. Susan A. Cole

The University held a Graduate School Commencement ceremony on January 17, 2020, at the New Jersey Performing Arts Center. A Doctorate of Laws, *honoris causa*, was conferred on New Jersey Attorney General Gurbir Grewal in front of 700 Masters and Doctors recipients. New Jersey First Lady Tammy Snyder Murphy attended a New Jersey Maternal Health Day event on campus as well as an event sponsored by the Feliciano School of Business to promote scholarship surrounding the issues of human trafficking. President Cole announced that the AACSB formally reaccredited the Feliciano School of Business, noting that the school received very positive comments from the reviewers.

Union Report

Professor Richard Wolfson spoke on behalf of AFT Local 1904. Professor Wolfson announced that the Council of New Jersey State Colleges had reached a tentative agreement with the State, and that he expected ratification to occur in a few weeks. Professor Wolfson then congratulated all the AFT members being reappointed and those faculty receiving reappointments to their third year.
